Barukh atah Adonai, Eloheinu, melekh ha-olam

Blessed are you, O Lord, our God, king of the universe

שְׁתַּחֲוֵינוּ וְקִיַּמְנוּ וְהִנִּיעֵנוּ לְזֶמַן תְּהֵאֵת: (אָמֵן)

shehecheyanu v'kiyimanu v'higi'anu laz'man hazeh. (Amein)

who has kept us alive, sustained us, and enabled us to reach this season
(Amen)

Blessing for Dwelling in the Sukkah

This blessing should be recited at any time you are fulfilling the mitzvah of dwelling in the sukkah, for example, before you eat a meal in the sukkah or fellowship in the sukkah.

leishev basukah (Amein).
